It is envisaged that a number of papers from this Conference will be published in special issues of established journals in the forthcoming months. Paper Submission Abstracts of papers and/or session proposals should be submitted by March 15th, 2006 to the scientific committee of the conference as attached files (doc or pdf format) at the following address eefs@eap.gr Abstracts of no more than 200 words should contain JEL classification codes. The authors' full name, affiliation, address, phone/fax, and e-mail for correspondence should also be indicated. An entire paper may be submitted, when available, but it must include an abstract. Proposals for complete sessions are also encouraged. Each session should be made up of three papers. We welcome equally theoretical, empirical and policy-issues papers. Participants are expected to serve as program chair at Conference sessions. Authors whose papers are selected for the conference should send an electronic copy of the final version of their paper by April 15th 2006 in order to facilitate its reproduction for the relevant session.
