Call for papers (including a short description of the special session topic) Please note that a special session would normally consist of three papers that are related to each other. All special session topics are welcome. The Annual Conference Scientific Committee will review the special sessions proposals. An answer will be given to special sessions organizers by December 15, 2012. Further, the papers for these special sessions will be refereed by the special session organiser using the INFER standards (i.e. INFER referee report form).
