A Combinatorial Model for National Data Abstract We report on recent research work on using Social Accounting Matrices (SAM) to model the Libyan Economy. The SAM methodology is particularly useful for modeling the economic and social systems of emerging economies. We report on issues relating to the selection of sectors for inclusion in the model, implementation of the model on a computer and the potential contributions of the approach to modeling national data. The research incorporated the SAM methodology within a Stackelberg game framework as an aid to multiyear planning. We report on strategic insights gained by this approach.
